PRAYER POINTS - COVID-19 Pandemic

1. Government

- a. To make and implement the right and effective policies with wisdom to reduce the spread of the disease.
- b. To have good coordination between various government ministries and agencies in implementing and enforcing the policies.
- c. To prioritise handling of this pandemic above all else

2. Movement Control Order (MCO)

- a. Pray for good implementation, enforcement and adherence to the MCO
- b. Pray for better public education and communication
- c. Pray that there will be no panic nor excessive fearful reaction among the public
- d. Pray that it will be an effective method for containment of the pandemic
- e. For the health and protection of grab/food panda and food delivery workers

3. Health services

- a. Pray for the nurses, doctors and supporting staff. Protection for them and their families
- b. Pray for availability of essential medical supplies e.g. medicines, ventilators, oxygen tanks, PPE kits, COVID-19 test kits.
- c. Comprehensive contact tracing is now practically not possible due to increasing and growing number of clusters. Pray for effectiveness of screening, containment and other medical measures.

4. Patients with COVID-19

- a. Pray for COVID-19 patients and their family. Malaysia reported 2 COVID-19 deaths.
- b. Pray for Pastor David Cheng's family (Pr David is Malaysia's first COVID-19 death). Full recovery for his wife and daughter. 2 more deaths in Sarawak.
- c. Other churches like DUMC and Pantai Baptist affected and under quarantine.

5. Church

- a. Pray that although churches cannot have their regular meetings and services, the body life of the church will continue.
- b. Pray for effective online church meetings and other alternatives.
- c. Pray that the Church in Malaysia will be the salt and light for the nation.
- d. Pray for ministries in PJEFC that are vulnerable to cancellations of meetings
 - **Impact youth**- Impact youth is having online meetings. Pray for good level of engagement
 - **Migrant ministries**

6. The vulnerables

- a. The elderlies who have limited mobility and poor access to limited amenities
- b. Non contact workers, workers in gig economy, low income workers with limited savings
- c. Undocumented migrants who are economically vulnerable and may lose employment

7. Economy

- a. The pandemic will probably cause the greatest economic depression in a generation. Pray for good economic policies from the government and world bodies
- b. Prayerfully consider helping others who are less able to weather this economic crisis

8. International

- a. There are a lot of countries in the world with much less resources than Malaysia and this pandemic will hit them even harder. Please intercede for them.
- b. World Health Organisation (WHO) and its director general Dr Tedros Adhanom. Pray for wisdom and effectiveness in managing this outbreak.
